Dear Mr. O'Reilly,

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

"Under the FOI Act 2014, I am seeking the following in relation to funds given for humanitarian assistance in Syria by the Dept in cooperation with Dept of Trade

- a) A full breakdown of accounts for the 'Syria Crisis' aid going back to its inception listing those who received funds and what those funds were used for.
- b) Any groups which were refused funding and the reasoning given
- C) Whether the humanitarian group Syria Civil Defence aka The White Helmets received any funding from the Dept.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 27 November 2020.

I have identified 2 records that fall within the scope of your request. The records are listed in the schedule attached. I have made a decision to grant both of these records.

## Right of Appeal

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification. However, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this Department.
