I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

'All correspondence related to the publishing of a statement by Minister Coveney on 'recent attack in Mali' (dated 25 March 2019)'

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 29 January 2021.

I have identified **one record** that falls within the scope of your request. The record is attached. I have made a decision to grant the record.

You may also wish to refer to <u>Parliamentary Question number 15160/19</u> of 2 April 2019, which refers to the Minister's statement and to the events in Mali concerned by the statement.

Right of Appeal

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification. However, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this Department.
