

What you will need to apply online:

- Digital passport photo
- A valid email address
- A credit or debit card

- Passport book (simple renewals)
- Printer (complex renewals and first time applicants)

Online application process



Passport Photo Guideline

You can use the camera on your phone to take your new passport photo, at no extra cost.

The system will indicate you have reached the baseline requirement for the passport photo by advancing you to the next stage of the application.

The photo guidelines state:

- 1. You cannot take a selfie, as you need to be a bit further away than your arms will reach
- 2. The zooming function should not be used, and
- 3. Stand in a well-lit area so there are no shadows on your face and use a white wall as background.

You can use your personal computer or a smartphone







Commence application by selecting the appropriate status of your passport Upload your selected photo using your electronic device Input personal details and current passport details for renewals







Confirm your details





Passport Fees: Adult 10 yr - €75 / Child 5 yr €20 (€15 postage) You will be directed to a new payment page You can pay via credit/debit card Verify your credit card details







Application lodged







Your passport will be issued by the Passport Office in Ireland

Simple renewals

You will receive an email from the online team which will contain your application tracking number

First time applicants, complex renewals

You will receive an email from the online team which will contain your application tracking number and instructions regarding verifying your identity and submission of supporting documents.

Send supporting documents to the Passport Office in Ireland. The postal address is listed on your coverpage.

Your original documents and new passport will be returned to you separately via international registered mail.







Once your passport has been dispatched, you can track it via international post: Anpost or Australia Post
